

Connecting UniRubric to your LMS.

LTI 1.3 — the IMS Global standard your LMS already speaks. One self-service handshake per LMS. No plugin install, no vendor visit. Twenty to forty-five minutes from your IT admin, depending on platform.

UNIRUBRIC PROVIDES

- Five LTI 1.3 endpoints — login init, launch, JWKS, OIDC discovery, deep link.
- Signed tool configuration JSON, copy-pasteable into your LMS registration form.
- Live verification panel — one click runs the handshake and reports Auth · NRPS · AGS · Deep Linking pass/fail.
- Per-LMS appendix with the exact field labels you will see during registration.

YOUR LMS ADMIN PROVIDES

- LMS admin role on a sandbox or production instance (Canvas Root Admin, Moodle Site Admin, Blackboard System Admin, Brightspace Super Admin).
- Twenty to forty-five minutes of admin time, depending on LMS.
- Permission to enable three LTI Advantage services: Names & Roles, Assignments & Grades, Deep Linking.
- A lecturer test account on one course for the launch handshake.

FIVE FIELDS, RETURNED TO US

Your admin registers UniRubric inside the LMS, then hands these five values back. We paste them into our admin panel.

REALISTIC TIME PER LMS

Canvas	~20 min	Self-service in Developer Keys
Brightspace	~20 min	Self-service in Manage Extensibility
Moodle	~30 min	Self-service, a few extra clicks
Blackboard Ultra	~45 min	Registration via Anthology Developer Portal

The slowest step in practice is calendar time with the LMS admin, not configuration time.

WHAT ACTIVATES THE CONNECTION

Registration on your side. Activation on ours.

Completing the LMS registration on your side does not activate the connection. Every new deployment lands inactive in our admin until a UniRubric officer explicitly activates it — typically once the contract is countersigned and any required payment has cleared. Until activation, every launch attempt from your LMS is refused with “deployment disabled”. Activation is revocable in one click, and optional pilot or billing-cycle expiry auto-disables the deployment at a scheduled moment without manual intervention. There is no shared password to leak or rotate; every pairing is per-deployment, cryptographically signed, and revocable by us at any time.
